## Honor's Courses

NFC Academy offers an Honor's Program for students who qualify in most all core academic disciplines in High School. To qualify for the Honor's Program and enrollment in one of the courses the students must have a minimum of an overall 3.0 GPA and a 3.5 GPA in the specific academic discipline of the honor's courses taken. Students will receive an additional .5 weighted GPA for each course successfully passed with a minimum of a "C" average. Students and parents should keep in mind that students who are scoring a "C" in an honors course may be disqualified from future honor's courses as expectation of honor's students would be for scores above that level. Students in the Honors Program should expect a work load that reflects the quality of an honor's course receiving a weighted GPA. There is an additional tuition charge of \$65 per year for each honor's course.
