



**NFC Academy Lesson Planner
Kindergarten 5/Weeks 19-35**

Homeschool Parent: While you will want your child to learn the Bible, remember at this age there needs to be a fun time while discussing something that will be important in their lives. It is important that Bible be age appropriate.

Weekly Format: Your Teacher's Book offers you several different weekly formats for the lesson series. We encourage you to do that which best fits your homeschool schedule. The various formats offered are for schools that may have classes 3-4-5 days. You can do what is best for your schedule.

Character Qualities: You will want to make sure these applications are made and to do so you will need to show how God's Word applies to even a kindergarten student. It would not be unexpected to see some younger children come to place their young lives in Jesus Christ as a result of these lessons. Every child is different so care needs to be used and follow them as God may direct them.

Activities: All students and especially young children learn from "hands-on" and we encourage you to do as much as possible as your time permits. A parent should find much pleasure in seeing their little ones in their own special way arrive at new understandings in the Bible. Rejoice with them as they do so.

Scripture Memory: Will serve the children well as they learn and repeat God's Word and you will be blessed as you see your kindergartner show their skills as they spend time memorizing God's Word.

Grading: At this age grades are not the most important aspect for kindergarten in Bible. We suggest you discuss with your NFC Academy Kindergarten Teacher how you want to treat Bible when it comes to grading.
