Daily Study Schedule

To be successful in home school it is important to realize that while schedules can be very flexible that does not diminish the required time which must be spent to complete the course of study. Having a schedule you follow is essential to completing the course successfully. Yes, the schedule can be very flexible, but the hours needed to complete the course will need to be accounted for in your schedule.

Option A – A typical full schedule

It is important to note that what is called "homework" in a traditional school may require you to spend additional time outside of the normal schedule you have established.

Option B - Focus on subjects more time and rotating days.

Option C: You may decide you work better by focusing on several subjects each semester and completing them and then next semester focusing on several other subjects. Your schedule could look like the following (keep in mind unless unusual circumstance exists we would want the student to have Bible over both semesters):

First Semester: Math, History, and Bible

Second Semester: Language, Science, and Bible.

Option D: Some students may work best focusing on one subject at a time. Keep in mind for those subjects where foundations are built on one year's work for the next that this could be an important consideration for a student to consider, but for some it may work well. While all study schedules require the student to work diligently and consistently, getting behind in this option is a situation the student will want to avoid because of the amount of work that is due daily in each subject.

Important

You may adjust the days and/or hours to better fit your schedule, keeping in mind that spending the hours in the subject is necessary each week to finish the course during your designated semester. It is important to note that what is called "homework" in a traditional

school may require you to spend additional time outside of the normal schedule you have established.

The above options are just that...what is important is that every student have a specific schedule they follow. If they don't there are often too many distractions to take their attention away from school work.
